We would ask that you pay your rent through the Association otherwise we don't receive commission on it. This commission is essential to run the Association as it pays for things like administration, printing these newsletters and carrying out maintenance on the sites. Also there have been major staff cuts in the Allotments Office and they could do without handling individual rents. And don't forget that if you are late (after the end of October) you have to pay a £10 late payment penalty charge. If you can't make any of these times contact the Secretary to arrange payment.

Road Spraying

We have had major problems with the council spraying programme and now will be doing the road spraying ourselves. If you have plot by the road on either site can you please keep the kerb clear of weeds. And please don't plant right up to the path, leave about 50cm clear to allow spraying without any risk to your plants. Weed spraying is essential maintenance that we are contracted to do; keeping your own kerb clear will help immensely.

Call for Volunteers

Allotments in Birmingham are now entirely dependent on volunteers and receive no subsidy from the Council. If we don't have an active association we could lose the allotments. We must have more people coming forward to help with site maintenance, general tidying and in the shop. Please, if you have an hour or two to spare at the weekend do volunteer. You don't have to sit on the committee to help!

Keys for Tennal Lane

There have been security concerns at Tennal Lane so we are planning to change the gate lock – there must be a hundred keys for the current lock that have never been returned. We will provide each plot-holder with one new key free-of-charge at the rent collection, and will change the lock when everybody has the new key.

Shop Opening Times

The shop will be open Sundays 11:00am to noon until the end of November and then will close for December and January. It will reopen, same times, in February 2015 (weather permitting).
